

Hop on – Hop off, Visby

Bus stops & attractions nearby

BUS STOP 1: Hamnplan

In the heart of Visby, right next to the guest harbour, you can find Hamnplan 5 which has plenty of restaurants, cafés and shops. Address: Hamnplan 5, 621 57 Visby

BUS STOP 2: Visby Ferry terminal

Terminal for Destination Gotland's ferry line between Visby and Nynäshamn. In the terminal you can find luggage storage. Address: Färjeleden 14, 621 58 Visby

BUS STOP 3: Cruise ship docks

Mooring for larger cruise ships. Address: Färjeleden 20, 621 58 Visby

BUS STOP 4: Kneippbyn

Kneippbyn is a resort filled with experiences for all ages. Here you can find a water park, adventure golf, high ropes outdoor activities, trampoline park and several types of accommodation, like Gotland's only 5-star camping site. Address: Kneippbyn 15, 622 61 Visby

BUS STOP 5: Söderport

One of the main gates is located where the Eastern wall meets the Southern wall. This tower has especially nicely crafted joints. Just inside the gate you can the square Södertorg. Address: Söderväg 1, 621 58 Visby

BUS STOP 6: Visby bus station

From here buses depart to destinations all over Gotland. Address: Östra Byrummet, 621 45 Visby

BUS STOP 7: Österport

One of the three large gates in the Visby City Wall that leads to the picturesque city centre. Address: Södra Murgatan 53, 621 57 Visby

BUS STOP 8: Visby airport

Visby Airport has departures, arrivals, car rental and other transport communications.
Address: Visby Airport, 621 41 Visby

BUS STOP 9: Lummelunda

The Lummelunda caves are one of Gotland's most popular attractions and one of Sweden's longest cave systems, reaching 4,5 kilometers. The guided tours take place in the outer parts of the cave system. Address: Lummelundsbruk 520, 621 71 Visby

BUS STOP 10: Gustavsvik

The beach by Gustavsvik is 200 meters long. Here you can rent cabins, apartments and single rooms and explore nature paths and hiking tracks. Address: Snäckgårdsvägen 50, 621 41 Visby

BUS STOP 11: Norderport

Norderport is one of the oldest towers, as well as one of the three large gates, in the Visby City Wall. Within close walking distance you can find the Visby Botanical Garden that was built in 1855. Today it's a popular and tranquil garden. In the southern part you can find the S:t Olof church ruin that dates back to 1102. Address: Odalgatan 9, 621 55 Visby
